MARBELLA

Marbella is a city and municipality in southern Spain, belonging to the province of Málaga in the autonomous community of Andalusia.

The Sierra Blanca Mountains are the backdrop to 27 km of sandy Mediterranean beaches, villas, hotels, and golf courses.

West of Marbella town, the Golden Mile of prestigious nightclubs and coastal estates leads to Puerto Banús marina, filled with luxury yachts, and surrounded by upmarket boutiques and bars.

WEATHER

May is a great time to visit Marbella with the weather starting to become very favorable as summer approaches. The average temperature throughout May is 18°C (64°F). Average highs rise to 23°C (73°F) which are mostly experienced in the beginning ten days of the month, with the rest of the month seeing daily highs rise to 26°C (78°F). Average lows go down to 13°C (55°F) and are also mostly seen in the beginning ten days of the month, with the rest of the month having daily lows get up to 16°C (61°F).

GETTING AROUND IN MARBELLA

WALKING:

Both Marbella and Puerto Banus are compact so walking around them is easy. In Marbella you have the Old Town with its Adalucian charm, beautiful parks and the famous exciting seafront. In Puerto Banus you have the restaurants, clubs, top class shopping and the swanky harbour.

CYCLING:

What a fabulous place for cycling. For those who want a leisurely ride, the Paseo Maritimo is ideal. So much to see and absolutely flat between Marbella and Puerto Banus. Pass the 5 star hotels, the pine forests, the beautiful sea vistas, the parks, Roman remains and small restaurants and churingos, finishing in the brash harbour of Puerto Banus with its expensive cars and yachts.



BUS:

Public transport in Marbella is run by a company called CTSA-Portillo; its local buses run day and night and connect all the different areas of the municipality of Marbella. The local routes mean that you can get to all the areas in Marbella, from San Pedro de Alcántara and Puerto Banús to Elviria or Las Chapas. No matter where your apartment or hotel is, you are almost certain to be near a bus stop. If you don't have a car or want to use the local buses to get around, you can purchase a "Bonobus" card that will give you a discounted rate per trip. It is a rechargeable card that you can buy in the Marbella bus station and other authorized sale points.

BOAT:

Take the Fly Blue catamaran and cruise from the Marbella port to Puerto Banus. It takes about 20 minutes and gives brilliant views of the Golden Mile coastline.

Step straight off your boat from Marbella right into the heart of Puerto Banus.



TAXI:

There are plenty of taxis in Marbella. If you can't find a taxi rank, a passing taxi will be happy to stop and pick you up. Tariffs vary between day and time but they are still good value. Marbella taxis use meters. Some taxis have credit/debit card machines, but have cash ready in case they do not.

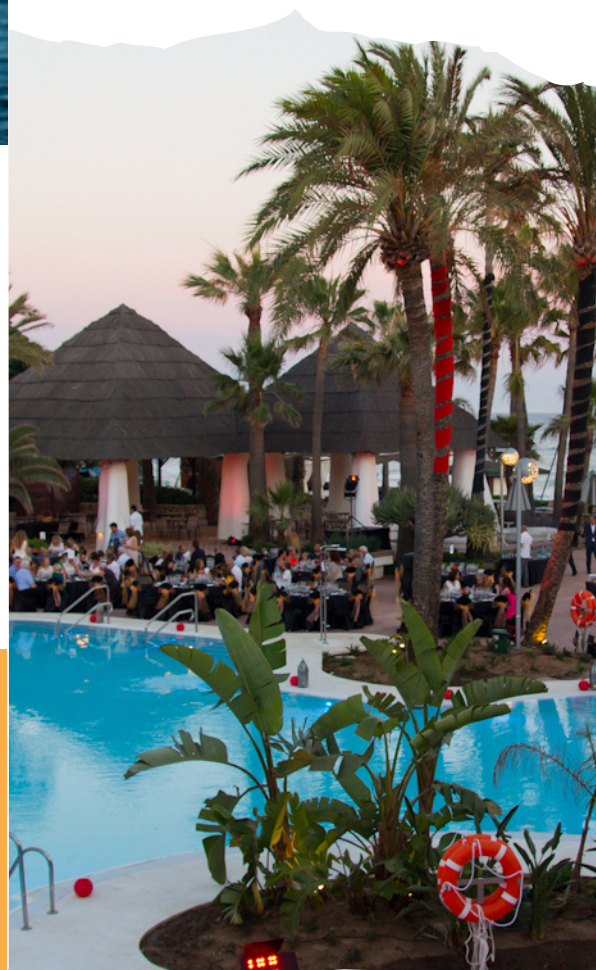

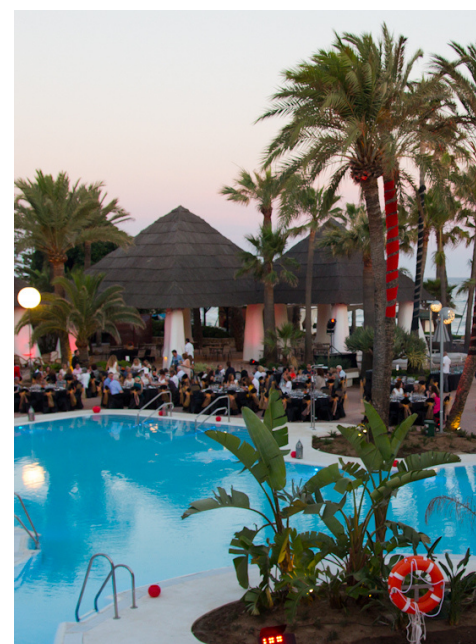

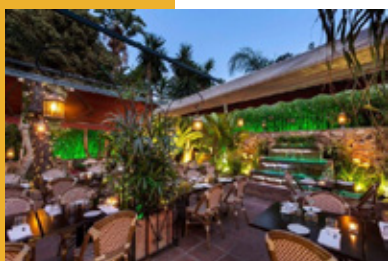
Abrasa BBQ is a steak house on the north side of Marbella's old town opposite the Municipal Market. Known for Argentinian meat of the highest quality.

What to See in Marbella:



Old-Town

The oldest part of Marbella is a real find. It's a labyrinth of pedestrian streets that are laid with red tiles and crazy paving.

The buildings are all whitewashed and topped with terracotta roofs, and many date back to the renaissance. Some are wrapped in bougainvillea; in fact the whole area is bright with flowers.

The houses are all arranged on corridor-like streets that emerge on little squares like Plaza de los Naranjos, where the square's restaurants place their seating in a small formal garden bordered by orange trees.

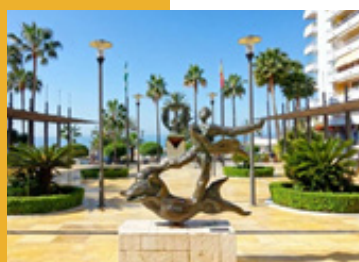
The old quarter is also kept spotlessly clean, to the point where the tiles shine in the sun.



Alameda Park

Just a few steps south of the old-town is a park that feels like a private garden.

Below a thick canopy of tropical foliage are marble-paved walkways, fountains and benches where you can hide from the sun in the afternoon or sip a cup of coffee in the morning.



Avenida del Mar

This handsome walkway leads down from the Alameda Park to Playa de la Venus next to Marbella's marina.

It's a broad pedestrian avenue with palm trees, meticulously-trimmed hedges and several pieces of great public art.

The bronze sculptures were designed by the 20th-century surrealist Salvador Dalí, so you could easily pass a few minutes studying them, perhaps from one of the beaches along the way.

Shops and bars line the walkway, and if you're visiting Marbella by car then there's a handy car park underneath this esplanade, with convenient access to Marbella's old-town and beaches.



Puerto Banús

A few kilometres east of old Marbella is the flashiest part of the resort.

If Marbella draws comparisons with the French Riviera, it's down to the boutiques, super yachts and luxury sports cars that meet your gaze everywhere you look in Puerto Banús.

The area merits some of your time just to see the ostentatious displays of wealth, but you should check out the large Rhinoceros sculpture, also by Salvador Dalí, which weighs 3.6 tones.



Iglesia de la Encarnación

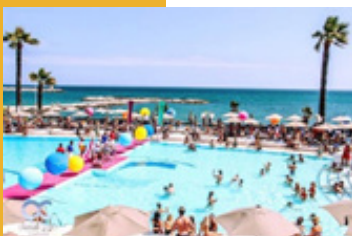
Marbella's main historic landmark is a splendid renaissance and baroque church completed in the mid-18th century.

The city wasn't "re-conquered" from the Moors until the end of the 15th century, much later than almost everywhere else in Spain.

This former mosque was sanctified straight away, and became a Christian place of worship centuries before work was completed.

Nightlife in Marbella:

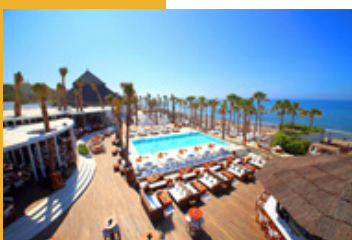
Marbella is famous throughout the world for its glitzy image and glamorous night life. Many of the exclusive venues are located in Puerto Banus and on the Golden Mile.

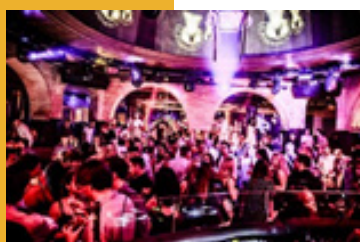


Nikki Beach Marbella
